COSMETIC PROPERTIES

Banana flower extract is effective against skin alterations and ageing process, due to its elevated contents of Vitamin E (* 2), which activates microcirculation of skin.

It is a cell antioxidant, which delays cell aging, improves elasticity of skin, and helps from appearance of wrinkles (*1, 3).

Vitamin E limits skin ageing, acts as a moisturizing and anti-inflammatory agent, protects against UV damage, improves blood micro-circulation
